Curb and gutter and bituminous paving of the westernmost 700 feet of Goad Drive and the southernmost 150 feet of Erickson Lane and construction of a stormwater management system involving properties along Goad west of Erickson, Erickson, and the north side of Mason east of Erickson and the lot lines parallel to and halfway between Goad Drive and Mason Drive

Public comments were heard and questions answered.

Motion by Kimmes; seconded by Martindale to adopt Resolution 19-02 (attached) authorizing TKDA to move forward with developing plans and specifications for the Goad Drive/Erickson Lane Street Improvement for Paving and Stormwater and to allow the city to move forward with the bidding and assessment process. Motion carried unanimously.

RESOLUTION NO. 19-02**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING
GOAD DRIVE AND ERICKSON LANE STREET
IMPROVEMENTS FOR PAVING AND STORMWATER**

FACTS

1. Curb, gutter and paving of the west section of Goad Drive has been considered for some time to eliminate repeated washouts of the north side. Drainage of the Erickson/Mason area has also been a concern as water collects and the planned drainage ditch running east from Erickson is not being utilized to alleviate drainage issues.
2. In July of 2018 the Wrenshall City Council adopted a Capital Improvement Plan with the improvement of the west section of Goad Drive as Priority #1 and improvement of Mason/Erickson as Priority #3.
3. On December 6, 2018, the City Council adopted an Assessment Policy to address funding of future improvement projects.
4. The Council hired TKDA to look at street improvement and drainage issues in the Goad/Erickson area.
5. The Council met and reviewed a Feasibility Report provided by TKDA and voted to proceed with Option 2 in accordance with the City's Capital Improvement Plan.
6. The City Council of the City of Wrenshall has heard and considered comments from concerned residents at a public hearing on Wednesday, January 23, 2019.

CONCLUSIONS

7. The proposed Goad/Erickson Project will address on-going maintenance issues and completion of the west section of Goad Drive; and
8. Will create a stormwater system to take care of drainage issues on Erickson and Mason.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY WRENSHALL, MINNESOTA that TKDA is hereby authorized to move forward with developing plans and specifications for the Goad Drive and Erickson Lane Improvements to move forward with the bidding and assessment process.
