The purpose of the public hearing was to consider public comment on curb and gutter and bituminous paving of the westernmost 700 feet of Goad Drive and the southernmost 150 feet of Erickson Lane and paving and ditching of 1300 feet of Mason Drive. The project also includes construction of a stormwater management system involving properties along Goad, Erickson and Mason Drive, utilizing an existing 26.5 foot-wide drainage easement that runs north and south parallel to and 400' east of Erickson Lane, and increases the size of the existing stormwater pond located at the southeast corner of the project area in addition to creating a drainage outlet for the stormwater pond

An overview of the revised project was given by Christian Lawien of TKDA. Public comments were heard and questions answered.

Motion by Mattinen; seconded by Martindale for TKDA to complete all necessary work to be ready for bidding with Carlton County when they request bids for Alcohol Road improvement in early 2020. Kimmes-YES; Ziebarth-YES; Mattinen-YES; Martindale-YES; Weiderman-YES. Motion carried.
